ADVENT PENANCE SERVICE

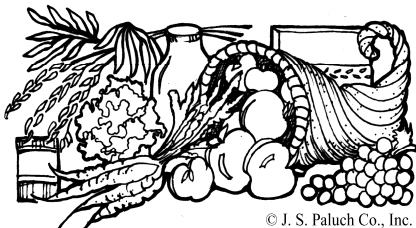
