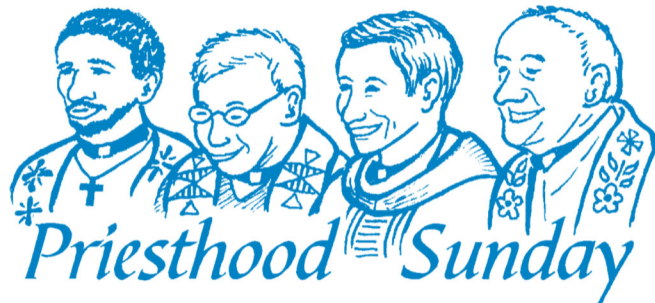

All we need do is call upon his grace, in the Eucharist, the Sacrament of Reconciliation, reading the scriptures. Let us hear the call of the Lord as we meet him, and then like Zacchaeus come into his presence finding Forgiveness, Hope, Joy and Peace!

The envelope for Marquette Catholic High School will also be collected in the same second collection. All loose donations though will be for the Archdiocese for Military Services.

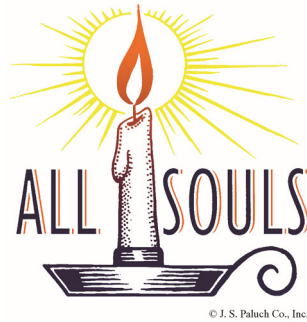
