MASS INTENTIONS 

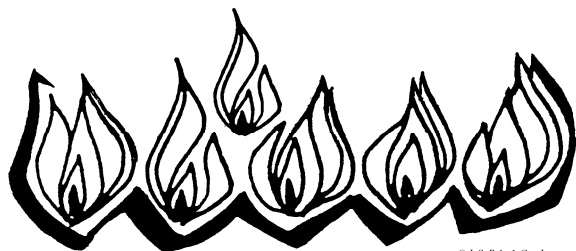
“Jesus said to them again, ‘Peace be with you. As the Father has sent me, so I send you.’”
